

HLTAID007 Provide advanced resuscitation

Application and Relevance

This unit applies to a range of industries where first aiders need to be trained in the use of specialised equipment in the provision of resuscitation, including defibrillators, medical oxygen and advanced airway management devices. It is relevant for designated first aiders, especially those working in construction, manufacturing, mining or any occupation involving remote or hazardous work.

Course Currency Status: current

Duration

8 hours face-to-face classroom/workplace training and assessment OR

Refresher course: 3 hours face-to-face classroom/workplace training and assessment with 2hrs workbook pre-work

Course Content

This unit covers the skills and knowledge to use specialised equipment to provide resuscitation in a range of complex situations, including community and workplace settings. It includes:

- + Suctioning of the airway
- + Use of oropharyngeal airway devices
- + Benefits of oxygen administration
- + Safe procedures for medical oxygen equipment
- + Administering oxygen therapy
- + Resuscitation using soft bag and mask and manually triggered oxygen powered devices
- + Safety procedures for AEDs
- + Administering defibrillation
- + Checks and maintenance of resuscitation equipment

Entry Requirements

There are no pre-requisite units for this course. It is recommended participants have language, literacy and numeracy skills equivalent to level 3 of the Australian Core Skills Framework (ACSF). They should also have the ability to meet the considerable physical demands of the practical skills. For the refresher program, participants must have a current in-date Statement of Attainment for this unit.

Assessment Methods

Progressive assessment throughout the course, including demonstration of practical skills and written and oral questions relating to underpinning knowledge. Note that the provision of CPR must be demonstrated on the floor.

Award Issued

A nationally-recognised Statement of Attainment will be issued to all successful participants.
